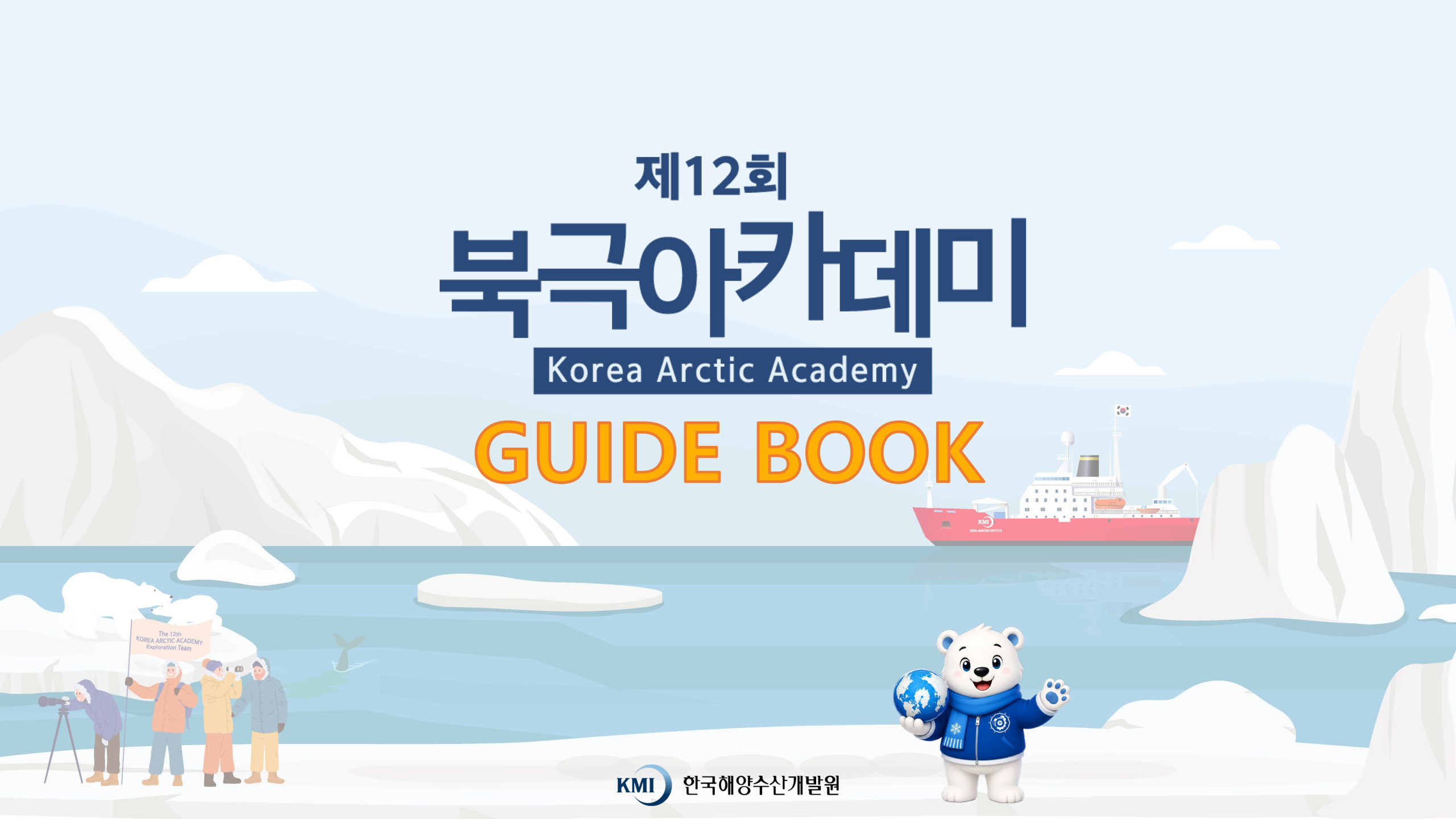

## Evaluation Criteria for Final Assignment



- **Final Assignment Format** : Prepare and submit PowerPoint presentation (PPT) on a freely chosen topic, such as Arctic policy, industry, humanities, science, etc.
- **Presentation** : Each participant will give a 3-minute presentation during the workshop session.
- **Deadline** : July 8 (Wed) PM 10:00 (KST)
- **Submission** : Via Google Form (<https://forms.gle/gLaYUdJzF9B4s4h76>)
- **Evaluation Standard** : PEER evaluation (30%) + 3 EXPERT Judges (70%)  
\*The panel of expert judges consists of 3 Arctic experts.

## Outstanding Student Selection

**Outstanding students** will be announced and **certificates of completion** will be awarded.



### Selection Criteria for Outstanding Students



- A total of 2 students will be selected:  
1 international and 1 domestic participants.
- Students are required to attend at least 80% of the lectures to be eligible.
- Selection Criteria:
  - Lecture Attendance : 40%
  - Participation in Q&A Sessions : 20%
  - Assignment Evaluation : 40%

### Reward



- 1 international and 1 domestic top-performing students will be selected and awarded separately.
- \*International students will be awarded 2 ECTS credits upon successful completion of the program.

# Evaluation Criteria for Final Assignment

Presentation of the final assignment is mandatory.

## Final Assignment

■ **Final assignment format** : Complete one PPT on a freely chosen topic, such as Arctic policy, industry, humanities, science, etc.

■ **Evaluation Standard** : PEER evaluation - 30% / 3 EXPERT Judges - 70%

※ The assignment evaluation will be based on the combined scores from the three expert judges and peer evaluations by participants.

■ **Free Topics** (Participant's Choice)

- Lecture Attendance: 40%

- Participation in Q&A: 20%

- Assignment Evaluation: 40%

- Assignment evaluation will be based on the combined scores from three judges and peer evaluations by participants.

• **Two top-performing students will be selected and awarded separately.**

■ Each of the 4 tasks is evaluated on the basis of 100 to derive an average grade.

Analysis and Argumentation	- Analysis of the research sources used to address the research problem. - Discussion of implications of the analysis and its relationship to the research problem. - Use of logical argument.	
Structure and Writing	- Maintenance of overall theme or point that gives the project coherence and significance. - Clarity, precision and economy of writing. - Accurate use of academic language and writing conventions appropriate for the specific task.
